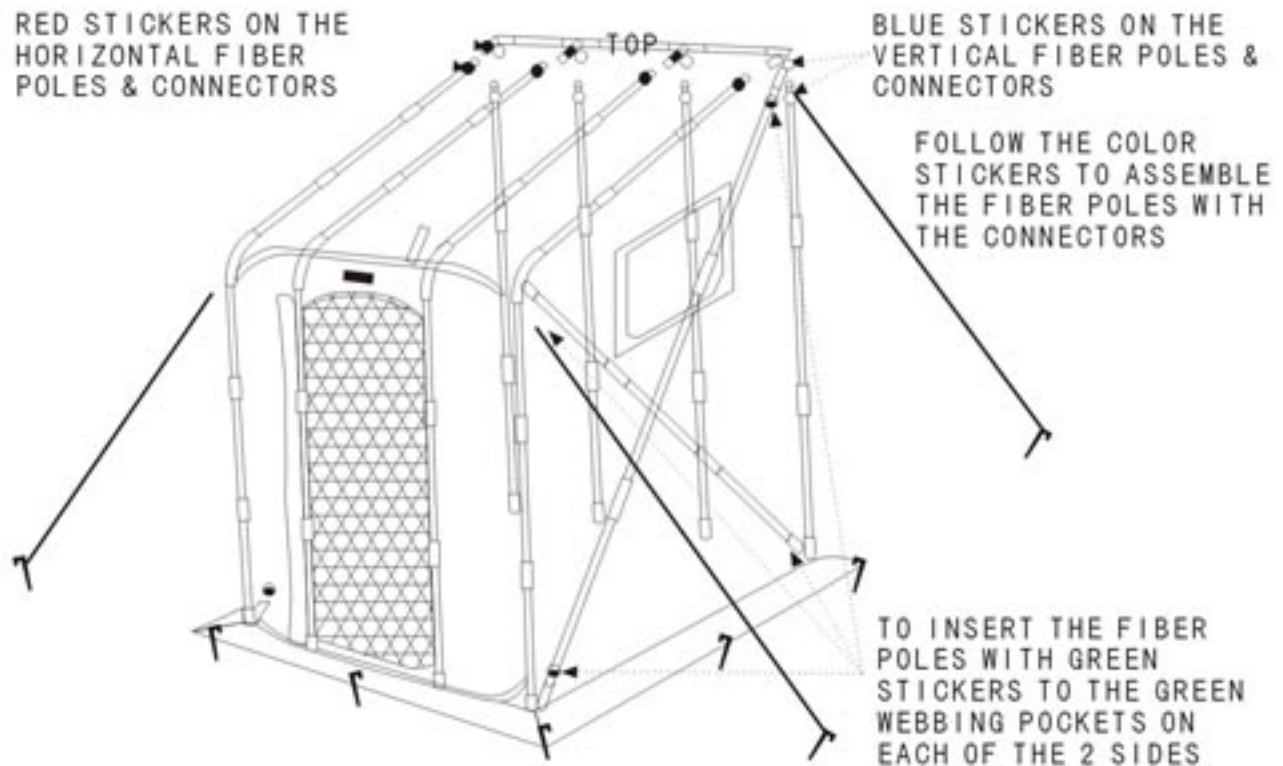


HOTHOUSE :

FIBER POLE AND TIE DOWN DIAGRAM



HotHouse set-up

Step 1. Unpack FlowerHouse and accessories, allowing the spring steel bands to pop open.

Step 2. Take fiberpoles out of pack and assemble completely. Ensure poles are fully seated into each other. You will have 4 "L" shaped poles, 4 straight poles, 2 longer straight poles and 1 straight pole with cross members.

Step 3. Install the sidewall support poles (the two longer poles) by inserting the poles into the pockets sewn inside the FlowerHouse in each bottom front sidewall corner. Insert the top end of the pole into the roof support pole (the pole with cross members) which is installed in the back roof peak.

Step 4. Install the back wall supports (four equal length poles) by inserting the top end of each pole in the roof support pole, then inserting the bottom end of the pole in the corresponding pocket sewn into the back bottom wall. (Hint: The pole has enough flex in it to bend while inserting into the pockets)

Step 5. Install the "L" shaped poles by inserting the top end into the fittings in the roof support pole. The bottom of the pole is inserted into the corresponding pocket sewn at the front edge floor, leave the pole off center till both ends of the pole are in place. Once both ends are installed, push pole into place.

Step 6. Stake Greenhouse in place and install high wind tie downs.

(Hint: Fiberpole pockets may be obscured behind the spring steel bands. Pull the band away from the wall and insert fiberpoles into pockets)

Fold Up and Storage Instructions

Although sizes differ dramatically the folding technique remains the same for these greenhouses.
(Helpful hint for best results be sure greenhouse is clean and dry prior to putting in storage / carry bag, use mild dish soap rinsed well then air dry is recommended.)



1. Remove all of the following where applicable, Shade Cloth, Tent Stakes, Fiber Poles and store them in the storage bag that they came in.
(helpful hint do not put accessories storage bags into main storage pack until greenhouse is fully packed and fit)

2. Fold your Flowerhouse from two panels into one as shown in figure A.
(helpful hint tuck excess material in between bands so it does not hang out beyond frame edge)

3. Choose one of the corners. With both hands, fold your Flowerhouse into a U shape like a giant soft shell taco, folding corner to opposite corner diagonally, as shown in figure B.

(helpful hint you will feel the tension of the spring steel this is ok)
 4. As the top corner in your hands meets the diagonally opposite corner on the Ground as shown in figure C, pull or tuck the top corner back Under toward your feet, as shown in figure D.
(helpful hint as you pull or tuck top corner back UNDER toward your feet you will feel tension release as shown in figure D.)

5. Then fold the ring on your left side and the right on your right side down over center ring forming 3 rings as shown in figure E.
(helpful hint the goal is to form 3 equally sized rings)

6. This completes the folding of your Flowerhouse lay it on the ground and kneel or press extra air out that was trapped during folding process as shown in figure F.

7. Returning the greenhouse to storage bag works best by holding the folded greenhouse between your knees and then pulling the bag over it, rotating slightly to fit it, then pushing the unit in completely, so not to stress the zipper, as shown in figure G.

8. Now you can place the accessories in their storage bags and next to or between the folded greenhouse. Now Greenhouse can be easily stored.
(helpful hint it is recommended that the greenhouse is then stored out of direct sunlight)
